

He Remembers

"Have you done what I asked you to yet?" someone asks you. "Oh I'm sorry!" you exclaim. "I forgot!" How easily we can forget things. In the busyness of life, things slip our memory - some important things, and others not so important. But, there is someone who remembers everything. Who is that? It is Yahweh. Yahweh is the Creator spoken of in the Scriptures. While a typical version reads "LORD", this is a replacement for "Yahweh". Yahweh is the Heavenly Father's Name. And He is the one who remembers everything. He knows all things. Even "**the very hairs of your head are all numbered.**" (Matt. 10:30) And He remembers all things too.

Yahweh does not just remember things - He remembers people, and He remembers you. Of all the millions of people that have ever been, that are now, and that ever will be, Yahweh knows everyone's name. He forgets not a one. All His faithful servants since the beginning of time are remembered by Him. He has written their names in the Book of Life. But, those who have not followed Him are remembered too. Though their names are not in the Book of Life, yet they are written in other books. "**And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahweh; and the books were opened; and another Book was opened, which is the Book of Life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.**" (Rev. 22:12) Yahweh knows about you, personally, and your name will be written somewhere. Where will it be? Yahweh's

remembrance is infinite. How will He remember you? As faithful or unfaithful? Yahweh said of Moses, one of His faithful servants who lived long ago, "**My servant Moses is faithful in all Mine house.**" (Num. 12:7) Would He say such a thing of you? Yahshua, the Savior of the world and the Son of Yahweh, is faithful. The Scripture says, "**Wherefore, set-apart brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Messiah Yahshua, who was faithful to Him that appointed Him, as also Moses was faithful in all His house.**" (Heb. 3:1-2) Are you one of Messiah's brethren, and a partaker of the Heavenly calling? Is Yahshua your Apostle and High Priest? Are you living faithful for Him? However you live, Yahweh will remember. He won't forget. But do you know what He says? He says, "**Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any man hear My voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.**" (Rev. 3:20) Yahweh is standing at your heart's door, knocking. Are you heeding Him? Yahshua offers life to you. He says, "**I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing. Therefore, choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live; that thou mayest love Yahweh thy Mighty One, that thou mayest obey His voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto Him, for He is thy life, and the length of thy days.**" (Deut. 30:19-20) "**I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no man cometh unto the Father but by Me.**" (Jn. 14:6) Yahshua is the door to salvation. There is no other way. Do you want to enter that door? Do you want that life He gives? You may have it, if you ask. "**Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh, it shall be opened.**" (Matt. 7:7-8) But, there are a few conditions you must meet.

1. You must acknowledge that you are

a sinner. "**All have sinned and fallen short of the esteem of Yahweh.**" (Rom. 3:23) "**There is none that doeth good, no, not one.**" (Ps. 14:3) You cannot be saved by doing good works, "**for by the works of the Law shall no flesh be justified.**" (Gal. 2:16) On your own, you can do nothing.

2. Because you can't save yourself, you need someone else to save you. That someone is Yahweh and Yahshua. Yahweh says, "**I am Yahweh, and beside Me there is no Savior.**" (Isa. 43:11) You must believe on Yahweh and Yahshua as your Savior. "**The just shall live by his faith (or belief).**" (Hab. 2:4) "**Whosoever believeth on the Son (of Yahweh) hath everlasting Life, and whosoever believeth not the Son shall not see Life, but the wrath of Yahweh abideth on Him.**" (Jn. 3:36)

3. Yahshua will save you, but you must be willing to let Him do that. Part of this "letting Him do it" is giving yourself up to Him. This means that you confess your sins to Him, and forsake them. Yahweh says, "**If the wicked will turn from all His sins that he hath committed, and keep all My statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die.**" (Ezek. 18:21) With all of Yahweh's infinite remembrance, He will put your sins behind Him, if you will give them up. "**Hide Thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.**" (Psa. 51:9) When He blots out your iniquities, He has no need or desire to remember them.

4. When you give your sins up, and give your life to Yahshua, your life is not your own any more. Your King is now Yahweh. "**Whether we live, we live unto the Master Yahweh; and whether we die, we die unto the Master Yahweh; whether we live, therefore, or die, we are the Master's.**" (Rom. 14:8) "...**bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Messiah...**" (2 Cor. 10:5)

5. Now that you belong to Yahweh, you are His child and He is your Father. "**Wherefore, come out from among**

them (the world) and be ye separate,' saith Yahweh, 'And touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be My sons and daughters,' saith Yahweh Almighty." (2 Cor. 6:16b-18) "For what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness? (2 Cor. 6:14)

6. When you have done these things, you are a renewed person. Indeed, "**ye have put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and you have been renewed in the spirit of your mind; and ye have put on the renewed man, which after Yahweh is created in righteousness and true set-apartness.**" (Eph. 4:22-24) As a renewed person, you must be set-apart / separate from the world. You are a part of Yahweh's family, instead of the family of the world. You are an adopted daughter or son of Yahweh. "**If ye live after the flesh, ye shall die; but if ye, through the Spirit, do mortify (overcome, put to death) the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of Yahweh, they are the sons of Yahweh. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, 'Father, Father'. The Spirit itself bearing witness with our spirit, that we are the children of Yahweh; and if children, then heirs; heirs of Yahweh, and joint-heirs with Messiah; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also esteemed together.**" (Rom. 8:13-17)

7. As the above Scripture says, when you become set-apart and renewed, there will be suffering that you will bear. Friends and family members may shun you. There may be people who won't want to employ you. You will not fit in with the crowd anymore. But do not worry. Yahweh says, "**Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed;**

for Yahweh thy Mighty One is with thee whithersoever thou goest." (Josh. 1:9) Again He says, "**Never will I leave thee, nor forsake thee.**" (Heb. 13:5) Hear this beautiful word of comfort: "**There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man; but Yahweh is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able, but will, with the temptation, also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.**" (1 Cor. 10:13) Thus we may confidently say, "**Yahweh is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.**" (Heb. 13:6)

8. Now as Yahweh's son / daughter, and as a renewed person, your life must be given to serving Him. Everything you do is for Him now. "**And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Master Yahshua, and not unto men; knowing that of the Master Yahshua ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance; for ye serve the Master Messiah.**" (Col. 3:23-24) You have freely received the glad news of salvation; now go and freely give others that news. "**Freely ye have received, freely give.**" (Matt. 10:8) "**Then will I teach transgressors Thy ways, and sinners shall be converted unto Thee.**" (Psa. 51:13) "**Therefore, brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of Yahweh, for as much as ye know that your labor is not in vain in Yahweh.**" (1 Cor. 15:58)

9. The Spirit of Yahweh bears witness with your spirit that you are Yahweh's child. Yahweh's Spirit restores you, and upholds you. But, you must be careful that you "**grieve not the set-apart Spirit of Yahweh, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**" (Eph. 4:30) "**For the set-apart Spirit of discipline will flee deceit, and remove from thoughts that are without understanding; and will not abide when unrighteousness cometh in.**" (Wisdom of Solomon 1:5) You must take your thoughts captive to Yahweh, do what He says, and have a heart after Him, or His

Spirit will be grieved, and flee from you. However, if you will live for Him and please Him, serving Him from your heart, your name will be written in the Book of Life, and Yahweh will forever remember you with pleasure. This means that you will live in the new heaven and earth, New Jerusalem, when Yahshua returns. Yes, you will live forever. For Yahshua says, "**He that heareth My word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting Life, and shall not come into condemnation, but is passed from death unto life.**" (Jn. 5:24) This can be a reality, for you, if you will say "Yes" to Him and His ways. Will you? It is your choice.
